**Conceptual core:**

These courses include the major theoretical trajectories and critical junctures in the history of psychoanalysis. The proposed curriculum reflects an effort to introduce the different theoretical strands within psychoanalysis by the end of the third year. The order in which classes are offered doesn't reflect a ranking of importance but is rather a reflection of the complexity of offering multiple languages within psychoanalytic thinking. The goal is to help the candidates develop a critical engagement with thinking analytically.

**Experiential core:**

These courses promote the internal capacities of the candidates to do analytic work and function in a group.

**Clinical core:**

These courses address two clinical areas:  
 1) the analytic process, phases and dynamic vicissitudes;  
 2) psychic structure and development.
